January President's Message

Dear Sister Columbiettes,

Do you love what we do? Do you have a willingness to serve our Organization?

President – Preside at all Auxiliary meetings and enforce the rules and regulations of the Auxiliary, appoint committees in and of her auxiliary, countersign vouchers issued by Financial Secretary, countersign checks drawn and signed by the Treasurer, give all correspondence to Secretary, schedule meetings and events for the Auxiliary, serve as primary liaison to the church, send out prayer requests and business matters through email as needed, perform other duties as the Order may impose.

Vice President – Preside in the absence or inability of the President and execute all duties of the President, performs other duties as the Auxiliary may impose.

Secretary – Record and edit the minutes from each Auxiliary meeting, roll call of officers at each meeting, present correspondence and bills to the auxiliary at each meeting, perform other duties as the Auxiliary may impose.

Financial Secretary – Collect and receive all monies due to the Auxiliary, collect and account for member's dues, pay over to the Treasurer all monies received to her at the meeting within 10 business days, keep a roll of members, addresses and degree dates, complete paperwork and submit to Supreme all paperwork pertaining to membership and degree status, monthly Financial Secretary report, annual 990 filing, other duties as the Auxiliary may impose.

Treasurer – Receives all funds from the Auxiliary (from any source) and deposits into the bank, pays Supreme Council all monies assessed, pays all orders which are signed by Financial Secretary and President, keeps separate accounts of money to show the amounts in the general expense fund and each and every special fund of the Auxiliary, monthly Treasurer's report, other duties as the Auxiliary may impose.

Sentinel – Prepare the meeting room, inspect travel cards, attend to the entrance of the meeting room, perform other duties as may be imposed by the President.
